Legislative Updates

- On March 31, 2021, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) added 15 audiology codes to expand the list of authorized telehealth services for beneficiaries. This will increase provision and reimbursement of teleaudiology services through the end of the COVID-19 pandemic. <u>See the</u> <u>list of codes added here!</u>
- The 10th state, Nebraska, has passed legislation to adopt the Audiology and Speech Pathology Interstate Licensure Compact (ASLP-IC), meaning the ASLP-IC is officially operational! The compact will now establish a Commission composed of one audiologist and one speech pathologist from each participating state to direct and oversee implementation. <u>For the latest</u> <u>updates, check the ASLP-IC website!</u>
