AUDIOLOGY UPDATE

Medicare Audiologist Access and Services Act of 2019 (H.R. 4056)

Patients will have access to audiological services without a referral from a physician. Audiologists will be reclassified as "practitioners," like other doctoral-level professionals such as clinical psychologists. The passing of this bill means appropriate services can be delivered to our patients in a more timely fashion. Supported by AAA, ASHA, and ADA.
