Collection of pop tabs are submitted to a partnering recycling company who then makes a monetary donation to our local Ronald McDonald House (RMH). Donations to the RMH are used to assist families whose children are being treated at our local children's hospital, as well as the children themselves. Families stay at the Ronald McDonald House for free or for a very low cost. Donations pay for room and board as well as basic supplies of living for families who may be staying at the RMH for months at a time while their child receives inpatient care. Ronald McDonald House Charities have locations all over the country near major children's hospitals.

Activity Description:

Students will collect pop tabs and place them in one of several collection canisters in our school. The humanitarian chair then delivers full canisters to the Ronald McDonald House, who then submits the pop tabs for the donation.
